

IDC Legacy Award for Distinguished Service

OVERVIEW

The IDC Legacy Award for Distinguished Service is the most prestigious individual award presented by IDC. The recipient of this award exemplifies outstanding service and dedication to IDC and more broadly to the interior design community in Canada. The award honours the individuals, companies or institutions that are recognized as being trailblazers to the design community nationally. The recipient is determined by the Awards Selection Committee and will be honored at IDC's awards celebration this fall.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- An ongoing commitment to interior design education
- A willingness to work with others to improve interior design recognition, nationally
- Ongoing commitment to advocacy, nationally and internationally
- Membership and engagement with IDC
- Appropriate long-term membership in other related associations
- Special contributions to IDC and to the interior design industry in Canada

APPLICATION GUIDELINES

The following materials must be submitted:

- Nominee bio
- Nominee photo (headshot, high-resolution)
- Minimum 3 letters of endorsement for the nominee (may be submitted by colleagues, students, supervisors, administrators, community leaders, etc.)

JUDGING CRITERIA

- Demonstrated service to IDC and the interior design profession nationally - 60 points
- Demonstrated commitment to interior design or related education - 20 points
- Engagement with the design profession, nationally - 10 points
- Professional presentations, publications, and/or legislative activities - 10 points

RECOGNITION

- IDC member(s) will be honored at a virtual awards celebration this fall.

Award:

- Custom trophy for Legacy Award winner(s)
- Certificate for Legacy Award winner(s)
- Badge/logo to use in company materials
